Coastal Promise is a full-scale multi-day field simulation. It recreates the challenges and conditions professionals encounter in complex emergencies characterized by conflict, disaster, and humanitarian need. During the event, participants, acting as members of a non-governmental organization, engage in intensive negotiations, humanitarian assistance, peacebuilding assessment, and human rights advocacy as part of a scenario based on a realistic conflict or humanitarian crisis.

To attend the event, you must be 18, a U.S. citizen or foreign national with a green card or visa, currently enrolled in a master's degree program, and up to date on all COVID-19 vaccinations. The \$600 registration fee covers all expenses. You may be able to apply for a scholarship that can reduce the fee to \$300.
